The 2023-2024 season will introduce new Adidas uniforms for CESC. The uniform cycle is for two full years (Fall 2023 - Spring 2025) and is consistent for all CESC teams from Pre-Academy to Senior teams. Players are required to purchase the entire uniform package (in photo) from TeamHubSports, a division of Soccer Village.

Note: Goalkeepers will be required to purchase a different game uniform. Any goalkeepers that want to play as a field player must purchase a field player uniform.
