PLAYER SAFETY

SUPER CLUB

- Two-Deep Policy & Buddy System: Common sense to ensure players are never alone 1:1. Players need to use restroom before training begins.
- **Keep Non-CESC People Away From Fields:** "Can I Help You?" Parents to be behind fence line or in parking lot.
- Concussions & Injuries: When in doubt, sit them out. Coaches to relay of suspected injury or concussion to the parents.
- Anti-Bullying: We won't tolerate bullying. If there is suspected bullying, please relay to DOCs. Coaches will intervene as instructed.
- **Weather & Lightning:** We will try to train unless otherwise communicated from DOCs. Lightning range is 10-miles or less. Send to cars or shelter. *My Lightning Tracker Pro* app is encouraged.

- ★ Demonstrate Respect & Professional Relationships Towards Players, Parents, Opponents, Coaches, Officials, And Spectators
- Refrain From Profanity, Alcohol, Drugs, And Tobacco
- Refrain From Conversations Regrind Playing Time Or Positions
- Adhere To 24-Hour Policy Before Discussing Frustrated Concerns With A Coach Or Director Of Coaching
- Never Criticize A Coach Or Player In A Public Manner
- **★** Instruction And Referee Interaction Are Prohibited
- **Stay Current With All Financial Agreements And Fees**
- **Expected To Be Punctual And Organized**



RELAY ABSENCES TO COACHES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE

TRAINING & GAME UNIFORMS



- Players are expected to wear ALL BLACK CESC GEAR to Training
- It is MANDATORY to bring all uniforms to the games
- Coaches / Managers may substitute
 Navy Socks in Muddy Conditions
- If players do not have uniforms, we will wear BLACK TRAINING GEAR if needed
- Each player will be given two Training
 Pennies; Put your name on these
 - Players will be charged \$10 a piece for replacement/lost Training Pennies





PARENTS & PERFORMANCE ENVIRONMENT




- 1. Keep Parents Informed & Communicate Regularly
 - Weekly Emails / Updates on Player Performance
 - Mid-Season & Post-Season Evaluations
 - Feedback on HOW Player's Can Improve
- 2. Be Respectful & Professional: Boundaries

RESPONSIBILITIES & DUTIES OF COLUMBUS EXPRESS COACHES & STAFF

SKYEEDDY: COACH-PARENT BOUNDARIES





If your child is feeling uninspired. Has your child been experiencing a lack of enjoyment around their soccer experience for a while now? While experiencing setbacks is something that occurs in sports... The parent and coach should feel like they are working together to make sure players feel inspired.

If you are feeling a lot of stress yourself. Being a soccer parent has its challenges, but overall it should not cause you a lot of stress

SKYEEDDY: COACH-PARENT BOUNDARIES





To report hostile sideline behavior. If you feel the coach is unaware of repeated hostile behavior on the sidelines during games, then it's absolutely appropriate to discuss this with the coach.



To express gratitude. Coaching is emotionally and physically demanding and you taking the time to express a message of gratitude to the coach will always be appreciated. If your motivations are free of any thoughts of manipulation, then absolutely the door is open to you to express gratitude.

SKYEEDDY: COACH-PARENT BOUNDARIES



To complain about a player. Unless it is a bullying or safeguarding issue the coach should be made aware of, the door is not open for you to discuss another player with the coach.

To question a decision a coach made in a game. Regardless of the outcome of coaching decisions, ultimately it is the responsibility of the coach to make game decisions.

To advocate for your child when they can advocate for themselves. If your child has the ability to approach the coach to facilitate a conversation, then you should give them that opportunity to learn and develop, and not approach the coach yourself.

DEVELOPING PLAYER ACCOUNTABILITY



- 1. GIVE PLAYERS RESPONSIBILITY TO PACK & CARRY THEIR BAG
- 2. PLAYERS SHOULD TAKE CARE OF THEIR CLEATS
- 3. PLAYERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR UNIFORMS (SOCKS, SHORTS, TOPS)
- 4. PUMP UP THEIR BALL & WRITE NAME ON IT
- 5. PLAYERS PREPARE THEIR OWN WATER & SNACKS
- 6. HAVE PLAYERS CONFIRM ATTENDANCE ON TEAMSNAP (IF ABLE)





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
